- Seating of Sen. Doug J ones (D$A L$ ) reduces $R$ Senate majority to one vote
- Generic congressional polls favor Democrats by $+6.5 \%$


## Outlook for November Elections

- Democrats are energized by recent flips of Republican seats in AL, PA
- Hopes are high that a "blue wave," powered by backlash against President Trump, portendsa Democrat majority in the House
- Senate a longershot
- Republicans continue to highlight major accomplishments
- Tax reform
- Supreme Court justice confirmation
- Deregulatory agenda
